

Minute of Remembrance for Kenneth Zane Wulff Thomas
July 22, 1991 - August 6, 2022

Zane Thomas, son of Barb Wulff (member) and Kenneth Thomas (attender), died on August 6, 2022 at 31 years old. Zane shared his enthusiastic spirit with First Day School and the Meeting as a child. As a man, he shared his son Aiden with us. Those of us who have been in the Meeting for years knew Zane; those of us who are newer to Meeting, know Aiden. We deeply mourn Zane's shining spirit which the family explained so well in his obituary:

On Saturday, August 6, 2022, Kenneth Zane Wulff Thomas, born July 22, 1991, left this world. He was born a child of wonder - gregarious, curious, mischievous, and open-hearted. He was the spark that kept our family moving and traveling-to Costa Rica, New Zealand, and Africa; to roller coasters, museums, beaches, hiking paths. He was a child (and man) of the forest who left no stone or log unturned, just to see what life lived underneath. His knowledge of how things worked was wide, varied, and creative.

He was a tinkerer, artist, and entrepreneur. He loved to bring new life to old or discarded things. He was a gift giver of the most generous kind-heart shaped rocks, tools, bird houses, paintings, found objects, the correct cords for electronics.

Zane leaves behind a family who misses him dearly - Kenneth Thomas and Barbara Wulff, his parents, of South Toe; his wife, Megan Swartz and son, Aiden Wulff Thomas of South Toe; his brother, Silas, sister-in-law Amanda, and nephews Sawyer and Scout, of Jacks Creek; his mother- and father-in-law, Myrtle and Richard Swartz of Grassy Park, South Africa.

His biggest pride and joy was his son Aiden, age 6, who has his same big heart, gregarious nature, and curiosity, and who will carry on his dad's love of people and the world.

We, his family, are grateful for Zane's life, for all he taught us, and for the love we shared.
